2800	Alcohol Drug – Intro 1	In a moment we are going to ask if you drank alcohol or took any drugs or medications , at the time of the assault. This is very important information for police because one of the criminal offenses that may be investigated and prosecuted is when someone cannot legally consent to sexual acts due to the effects of drugs or alcohol. 2805	Alcohol Drug – Intro 2	These questions are not asked to blame or judge you, even if you were drinking underage or taking drugs illegally. The most important concern is the sexual assault , and it is important to understand exactly what happened.	NEXT
2810	Alcohol Drug – Intro 3	We will also ask whether the person (or people) who sexually assaulted you were drinking or taking drugs.	NEXT
2815	Alcohol Drug – Intro 4	Remember, you can skip any questions you do not feel comfortable answering, and you can provide as much or as little information as you choose. If you decide to report your sexual assault to police, the officer will probably ask you about this again.	NEXT
2820	Alcohol Drug – Intro 5	If you think any drugs may have been used to commit the sexual assault against you, please consider having a medical forensic exam as soon as possible .
